

COURSE EQUIVALENTS IN ECONOMICS

Important Notes:

- 1) These are course equivalents from the Department of Management at UTSC point of view, valid for UTSC students only (for programs offered by the department of Management).
- 2) Prerequisites are strictly enforced on all campuses.
- 3) UTSC students hoping to take (economics) courses at UTSG or UTM should make certain you satisfied the prerequisites of the respective campus (see the appropriate campus Calendar). Otherwise you will be removed from UTSG and/or UTM courses in mid term, and risk losing tuition fees paid. Permission to enroll in courses on another campus normally comes from the department offering the course.

Warnings:

- Exclusion does NOT mean courses are equivalent;
 - Many courses at UTSG & UTM have (one or more) full courses as prerequisites (completion of a half course that excludes the prerequisite is NOT sufficient to satisfy a prerequisite); and
 - Do not take courses that are exclusions to courses you have previously passed. No credit can be earned in such cases.
- 3) This is NOT a complete list of exclusions. Exclusion does NOT mean course(s) are equivalent. Courses at the St. George or Mississauga campuses which cover the same/similar material but at a lower (or even higher) level would also be included in a list of excluded courses. See the [UTSC Calendar](#) for exclusions.
 - Be careful to ensure courses are completed in the proper sequence. Higher level courses exclude lower level courses that are normally either the prerequisite or even lower than the prerequisite, of the higher level courses.
 - 4) Transfer Students who have been NOT been granted the specific credit(s) their program(s) require should seek counseling. When doing so at a minimum they should bring a copy of their transfer credit assessment letter.
 - Transfer credits for any full course (1.0 FCE) in Calculus will be treated as sufficient for the MATA32H plus MATA33H requirement; and
 - Any transferred statistics credit equivalent to or that excludes STAB22H will be treated as sufficient for ECMB11H.
